Manipulate the tail end of the button knot to make three knots the same way you made the earlier loop. Then push the tail ends of cord to the back and cut off extra. Hand stitch everything in place. How to attach the frog closure to your clothes. You need to hand sew it with some anchor stitches with a matching thread.

Decorative frogs can be made of purchased cord or of self-fabric corded tubing. Pin the frog into the desired design, securing each loop with small stitches on the underside. Slipstitch the frog to the garment, leaving one loop extending beyond the garment edge for

Pull each end of the cord until a knot forms. Tighten any loose cord loops by pulling them until the knot forms. Work the cords on the knot to form the Chinese frog button. The loose ends can be cut to complete the button, or they can be used to fashion the frog fasteners on your garment.

Position the frog so that the long back legs are facing you, and fold it in half, near where the body is narrowest. Make sure to fold the legs underneath the "body" of the frog. Crease the fold. 2. Make a crease for the frog's back legs. Keep the frog folded in half, with the back legs facing you, and turn it over.

Made from corded fabric, Chinese frogs consist of a knotted ball and an elaborate, continuous loop resembling two horizontal clover shapes connected by a double horizontal line. To close a Chinese Frog, insert the ball button into the portion of the loop overhanging the edge of the fabric. Cut 8 to 10 inches of corded fabric tubing.

From his impoverished upbringing to his tragic suicide in exile, Kazan's life and work reflected a turbulent period in Japan's history. He was a famous artist, a Confucian scholar, a student of Western

culture, a samurai, and a critic of the shogunate who, nevertheless, felt compelled to kill himself for fear that he had caused his lord anxiety. Although he remained a nationalist committed to the old ways, Kazan called on the shogunate to learn from the West or risk disaster. He strove to improve the agricultural and economic conditions of his province and reinforce its defenses, but his criticisms and warnings about possible coastal invasions ultimately led to his arrest and exile. *Frog in the Well* is the first full-length biography of Kazan in English, and, in telling his life's story, renowned scholar Donald Keene paints a fascinating portrait of the social and intellectual milieu of the late Tokugawa period.
