Your raw score is your point total on the SAT Subject Test before it's been converted to your final score on the 200-800 point scale. So if there are 60 questions, the highest raw score you could get would be 60.

The SAT Scoring Scale carries a maximum possible score of 2400, with each section (Critical Reading, Math, and Writing) scored on a 200-800 point scale. SAT scores are based on a student's percentile relative to other students taking the same test. The percentile score is then converted into a score ranging from 200 to 800.
