La rivista "Linus" nasceva cinquant'anni fa, nel mese di aprile del 1965, con dei padrini d'eccezione. Umberto Eco, infatti, intervista Elio Vittorini e Oreste Del Buono proprio nella prima pagina. In "Linus" numero 1, in particolare, si pubblicano le storie dei Peanuts di Charles M. Schulz, Li'l Abner e Krazy Kat, e un episodio completo di Braccio di Ferro. Popeye, tuttavia, era una vecchia conoscenza proprio di Elio Vittorini che nel lontano 1946 nella rivista "Il Politecnico" aveva inserito delle strip in lingua originale senza didascalie e con i balloon. Era stato l' intellettuale siracusano ad aprire per primo le porte della cultura ai fumetti sulla rivista "Politecnico" da lui diretta dal 1945 al 1947. Nell'intervista con Eco e Del Buono, Vittorini raccontava della sua passione per i fumetti, conosciuti dall'infanzia con il "Corriere dei piccoli", e dei suoi tentativi di sottrarli al genere della sottoletteratura presentando su Politecnico "storie a quadretti" di Disney e i comics di Popeye e di Barnaby. Nel saggio l'analisi dei fumetti pubblicati su Politecnico, un approfondimento su Vittorini e i Peanuts e un' Appendice sulla polemica sui fumetti dalle colonne di Rinascita degli anni 1951-1952.

*Francesca da Rimini - Storia di un mito* - Ferruccio Farina

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Il volume ricostruisce la storia del mito di Francesca da Rimini dal XIV secolo fino ai giorni nostri. Storia di profondi cambiamenti. Dall'antica Francesca da Polenta, la peccatrice dei versi di Dante, rappresentata per oltre cinquecento anni tra i dannati a monito dei lussuriosi, alla nuova Francesca, Francesca da Rimini appunto, figlia dell'Illuminismo e della Rivoluzione Francese, nata nel 1795 dai versi del poeta giacobino Gianni, non più peccatrice, ma vittima innocente di tempi e di leggi crudeli, iniziatrice del mito moderno. E, ancora, dall'eroina virtuosa e pura di Silvio Pellico che diventa musa ed emblema dei movimenti libertari europei e americani, a Francesca "guerriera" di Gabriele D'Annunzio e di Riccardo Zandonai, donna padrona della sua sessualità che affascina femministe e suffragette di qua e di là dell'Atlantico. Fino a Francesca icona del bacio degli innamorati, all'apice della popolarità nella metà del Novecento. Un volume che spazia tra rime, tragedie, racconti, dipinti, sculture, musiche e narrazioni cinematografiche dedicate a questa affascinante creatura della poesia e della fantasia. Perché di Francesca realmente vissuta, di Francesca figlia di Guido signore di Ravenna, per certo si sa soltanto che è esistita tra il 1260 e il 1284 circa e che è andata sposa a Giovanni Malatesta: nulla è stato tramandato di storicamente comprovabile dei suoi presunti o reali amori peccaminosi e di duplici omicidi.

**Charlie Chaplin's Last Dance** - Fabio Stassi 2014-04-03

'A day without laughter is a day wasted.' It is Christmas Day when Charlie Chaplin receives a visit from Death. The great actor is 82 years old, but not yet ready to face the final curtain. Desperate to see his teenage son grow up, the actor strikes a deal: if he manages to make Death laugh, he will win an extra year of life. As he awaits his final, fatal encounter, Chaplin composes an impassioned letter to his son, in which he attempts to tell him about his past, from his impoverished childhood in England (with an alcoholic father and a mother who went mad) to the heights of success on the silver screen in America, via stunts in the circus

and vaudeville, and odd jobs as a newspaper hawker, printer, boxer and embalmer. As well as being the story of the evolution of a comic genius, this is the story of the evolution of cinema and how a beam of light on a white screen fired the imagination of an entire nation. As in his silent films, Charlie's adventures are simultaneously tragic and comic. The narrative flickers at a frenetic clip from false starts and early failures to eventual triumph in the magical moment when - before the eyes of a stupefied film crew - Charlie became the Tramp: with a little moustache, a shuffling slantwise walk, a cane and a dusty bowler hat, one of the most iconic figures of the golden age of cinema was born.

Pinocchio, The Tale of a Puppet follows the adventures of a talking wooden puppet whose nose grew longer whenever he told a lie and who wanted more than anything else to become a real boy. As carpenter Master Antonio begins to carve a block of pinewood into a leg for his table the log shouts out, "Don't strike me too hard!" Frightened by the talking log, Master Cherry does not know what to do until his neighbor Geppetto drops by looking for a piece of wood to build a marionette. Antonio gives the block to Geppetto. And thus begins the life of Pinocchio, the puppet that turns into a boy. Pinocchio, The Tale of a Puppet is a novel for children by Carlo Collodi is about the mischievous adventures of Pinocchio, an animated marionette, and his poor father and woodcarver Geppetto. It is considered a classic of children's literature and has spawned many derivative works of art. But this is not the story we've seen in film but the original version full of harrowing adventures faced by Pinocchio. It includes 40 illustrations.
