Quest'opera costituisce l'edizione sistematica degli scavi e delle ricerche condotti tra il 2001 e il 2013 presso il Teatro del Pythion di Gortina di Creta dalla Scuola archeologica italiana di Atene e dall'Università degli Studi di Padova con la preziosa collaborazione della 23^ Eforia per le antichità preistoriche, classiche e bizantine di Iraklio. Il lavoro di cui qui si presentano gli esiti ebbe origine nel clima di profondo rinnovamento che caratterizzò la vita scientifica della secolare istituzione italiana in Grecia allorché E. Greco ne assunse la direzione nel 2000. Ma non ha potuto fornire risultati su un'altra questione cruciale relativa alle realtà preesistenti; infatti, a causa delle masse strutturali dell'edificio per spettacoli, i saggi di scavo non hanno potuto mettere in luce con sufficiente ampiezza i livelli di frequentazione antecedenti il II sec. d.C. e dare indicazioni sull'eventuale presenza di altri edifici (teatrato di altra natura) nel sedime del Teatro di età imperiale. Proprio attraverso queste lunghe riflessioni si è così arrivati all'idea di proporre l'esito della ricerca attraverso una presentazione estesamente analitica del lavoro svolto e dei dati acquisiti. Nei due tomi è quindi esposta l'interezza delle evidenze stratigrafiche, attraverso la loro narrazione testuale e la presentazione grafica (tomo I, parte II, capp. 1-10), ed è dato riferimento esauriente di tutti i reperti mobili sia attraverso il loro assemblaggio per contesti di giacitura sia attraverso la loro classificazione tipologica (tomo II, parte III). Pur essendo il lavoro articolato in ampie parti di sintesi e di interpretazione storica dei dati (tomo I, parte II, cap. 11), si è così mantenuta fede alla logica della presentazione integrale dei dati che, riteniamo, sia la sola che possa permettere a tutti gli studiosi interessati alle nostre ricerche non solo di giudicare le letture storiche conclusive, forse caduche e opinabili, ma anche di riprendere in esame le stesse basi di conoscenza per proporre o sostenere considerazioni storiche diverse da quelle avanzate.
