His novels, written for the most part anonymously, take place in the wake of two of the 18th century's great philosophical movements of Rationalism and Illuminism, and often combine scientific considerations with cabalistic, magical and alchemical ones. He is noted for anticipating many social and scientific inventions including photography, synthetic food and television.
