**L'ARCHEOLOGIA DEL GRAPHIC NOVEL** - Eleonora Brandigi 2013

The archaeology of the graphic novel does not shed light on the historical origins of the comic book; on the contrary, it tries to discover the conceptual genesis of this narrative form. If the research methodology is archaeological, in fact, the theoretical approach is the same as neuro-narratology, in the light of which four important stages are suggested. These stages define the comic novel as a "natural" literary genre, a mimesis of the process transposing reality into images and constituting the basis of thought. The figure of Rodolphe Töpffer is not excluded from this process. Thanks to his theories and his work, he leads us to hypothesize that the comic book was more "novelistic" at its origin than it is in its current forms: the path to the novel, then, would not be so much of an evolution, but rather a return to the origins.

Il Piccolo Principe fu pubblicato per la prima volta il 6 aprile del 1943 in inglese presso l'editore Reynal & Hitchcock di New York. Qualche giorno dopo, precisamente il 13 aprile del 1943, Saint-Exupéry salutò l'America per raggiungere le forze francesi in Algeria. Un viaggio da cui non fece mai ritorno. L'idea del libro nacque probabilmente a tavola, in uno dei ristoranti che l'autore frequentava in compagnia di Elisabeth, sua moglie, e di Reynal, l'editore. Saint-Exupéry disegnava spesso sui tovaglioli un piccolo saltimbanco che, avvolto in una sciarpa svolazzante al vento, poggiava i piedi nell'aria. Forse fu Reynal a suggerire di trasportare in un libro per bambini quel «ragazzino nomade», o forse fu Elisabeth. Fatto sta che, nell'estate e nell'autunno del 1942, Saint-Exupéry lavorò alacremente al progetto «con una dedizione quasi pazzo, stando sveglio intere notti, ingurgitando caffè nero e fumando un numero smodato di sigarette condite dal gin» (il manifesto). Il libro ha l'aspetto di una favola, ma è in realtà un «romanzo filosofico» che affronta i temi eterni della condizione umana: la solitudine, il senso della vita, il significato dell'amore e dell'amicizia. Nel 1946, a guerra finita, Gallimard diede alle stampe l'edizione francese dell'opera. Saint-Exupéry non ebbe dunque il tempo di vederla pubblicata in patria né di assistere al suo strabiliante successo. Tradotto in più di duecento lingue e dialetti (tra cui l'esperanto), viene riproposto in una nuova accurata traduzione integrale, condotta sulla base dell'edizione originale dell'opera e illustrata dagli acquerelli di Saint-Exupéry.
